

## Common Core Math Standards

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The knowledge and skills students need to be prepared for mathematics in college, career, and life are woven throughout the mathematics standards. They do not include separate Anchor Standards like those used in the ELA/literacy standards. The Common Core concentrates on a clear set of math skills and concepts.

Recognize that  $3 \times (18932 + 921)$  is three times as large as  $18932 + 921$ , without having to calculate the indicated sum or product.

The Illinois Learning Standards (ILS) for math K-12 are designed to help students acquire a deep, conceptual understanding of core math content through focus, coherence, and rigor.. Focus shifts teaching/learning from a mile long and an inch deep model to a deeper, richer understanding of fewer concepts.

To deliver on this promise, the mathematics standards are designed to address the problem of a curriculum that is "a mile wide and an inch deep." The math standards provide clarity and specificity rather than broad general statements. The standards draw on the most important international models for mathematical practice, as
