It is a succession of chords whose roots descend in fifths from the second degree to the fifth degree, and finally to the tonic. In a major key, the supertonic triad is minor, and in a minor key it is diminished. The dominant is, in its normal form, a major triad and commonly a dominant seventh chord. With the addition of chord alterations, substitutions, and ...
