The M551A1 Sheridan is the upgraded American version of the M551 Sheridan. Initially produced in 1966, the M551 was fielded in 1968. 1,562 M551s were built between 1966 and 1970. The Sheridan saw limited action in Vietnam, where many deficiencies were revealed.
